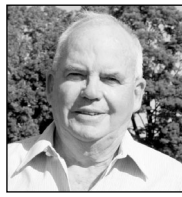
Dan is the seventh generation of Staleys in Rhinebeck. Many of his forbears were instrumental in making Rhinebeck the town it is today.
